



Competition announcement

Solo or Ensemble with clarinet

This **competition** is about the connections of classical music to other genres: Classical clarinet in relation to different musical styles (e.g. jazz) or art forms (e.g. literature, dance). A well conceptualized program is already part of the competition.

Conditions of participation

The international competition is open to clarinetists and their ensemble partners who were born after 1 January 1987. The number of participants in the first round is limited to 20. The order of submission is decisive. Deadline for applications is 1 July 2022.

The following must be submitted with the application:

- an uncut video with a maximum length of 20 minutes
- a fully completed application form
- biographies of all participating artists (max. 1,000 characters, running text form)
- a photo (resolution min. 300 dpi)
- a copy of passport or identity card for each participating person
- the name of the work to be performed, including the name of the composer/arranger and the publisher and, if applicable, a commentary for the jury.

All applicants will receive a confirmation as soon as their application has been received.

Incomplete entries are invalid and will not be considered.

Procedure and repertoire

A maximum of 6 to 8 of the submitted videos will be selected for the invitation to the second round in presence. The selection by the jury for this will be made by July 30th, 2022, immediately after which the participants of the second round will be informed. The program to be presented in the 2nd round should last approximately 45 minutes.
